Pastor Jao Mapa is a 2020 graduate of G.S.S.T. Because of the pandemic they were unable to have a formal graduation or a normal end to the school year, but Jao and his wife Joy, a 2018 graduate, returned to his home in Parañaque and to Pastor Paul Montano at the Vine's Church, Jao's home church. It has been their dream for many years to return home to Manila and plant a church.

The need is immense and the opportunities are so great. In any given week Pastor Jao may minister to 150 souls. These numbers are a result of the pandemic and the restrictions and ordinances placed upon them. Pre-covid, the number of people Jao would likely have ministered to would have been triple that. That is not being highlighted because we believe numbers are important in and of themselves, but to show how many people there are who need to hear the Gospel.

The location where Jao plans to plant his church is far from Moonwalk, his home, and eventually he and his family will have to move. He currently has 8 different Bible studies, each averaging an attendance of 15 people. He plans to gather them all for a combined service at the end of April. It is so exciting to see the Lord bringing this new church body to life!

Perhaps though, the Bible study nearest his heart is the one held in his own home. Please pray that his family would come to know the love and salvation of Jesus for themselves.
